- Health insurance that covers mental health treatment is associated with the receipt of needed mental health care
- Insured patients who are hospitalized for a range of conditions experience lower rates of death in the hospital, receive more services and are less likely to experience an adverse medical event due to negligence than are uninsured patient.
- Insured persons with traumatic injuries are more likely to be admitted to the hospital, receive more services when admitted and are less likely to die than uninsured trauma victims.
